

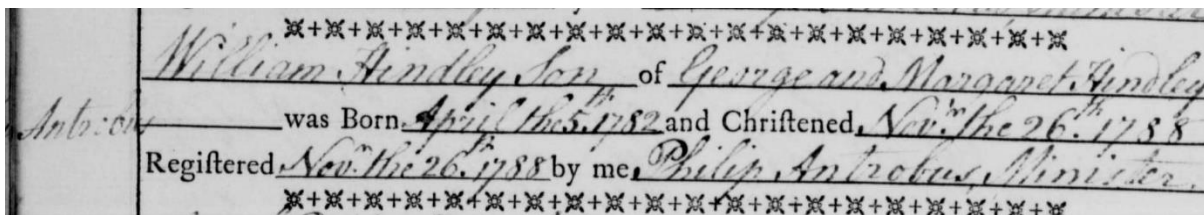

1782 William Hindley was the sixth child of George and Margaret Hindley. **GGGBBB**
His date of birth on 5th April 1782 was recorded on the original Christening entry at Lower Whitley Church.

1788 Lower Whitley Baptisms. MF 181
William Hindley, son of George and Margaret Hindley was born at Antrobus on 5th April 1782 and was christened at Lower Whitley Church on 26th November 1788. The Minister was Philip Antrobus. (Lower Whitley Church had only just been built.)



1802 Great Budworth Marriages. MF 62/3 ? William Hindley of this Parish (Great Budworth), bachelor, married Elizabeth Coups of this Parish, Spinster, on 14th September 1802 in the presence of George Burgess and Robert Oulton.

Coups was written as **Cowap** in the Bishop's Transcript.

Cowap is the most likely surname according to the frequency of names in Parish Registers.

1802 Great Budworth Baptisms. (From Bishop's Transcripts)
