At the time of the **1891 Census** Margaret was at 3 Denbigh Terrace, Egerton Street, Liscard, the home of Philip and Susannah Hoddey. She was 18, single, no occupation, and described as a visitor.

Margaret met a local man, Frederick Campbell O'Connell, who was born in the Birkenhead Registration District in the first quarter of 1869. In the 1871 Census Frederick C O'Connell was living with his parents John (b1824) and Eliza (b1830), 3 brothers and 3 sisters in Claughton Road, Birkenhead. Both of his parents had been born in Ireland.

Margaret and Frederick married on **6th August 1898** at Egremont Church on the Wirral.

At the time of marriage Frederick was living at 47 Seymour Street, Tranmere. Margaret was living at 85 Falkland Road, Egremont. Frederick was a Cotton Broker and his father was a Painter. Margaret's brother, George Henry Hindley, was a witness to the wedding.

After their marriage it is likely that they moved into 41 Caithness Drive, Liscard, as they were there for the **Censuses of 1901 and 1911**. Margaret's parents were living next door at number 39 and the properties were close to the river Mersey. Photographs can be found in the PROFILE of John Hindley (1830JOHN).
