Emily was born on 7<sup>th</sup> January 1866 at Antrobus, Cheshire.

She was baptised at St.Marks Church, Antrobus on 18<sup>th</sup> March 1866. Her parents are recorded as Joseph (shoemaker) and Ellen Hindley of Antrobus.

In the **1871 Census** Emily was 5 years old, born at Antrobus, and living with her parents at Pools Platt, Antrobus.

By the time of the **1881 Census** Emily (15) had started work, as a dressmaker. She was still living at home with her parents, Joseph and Ellen, at Pools Platt, Antrobus.

On **25<sup>th</sup> October 1887** she married Joseph Henry Bailey at Antrobus Church.

From the marriage certificate Joseph Henry Bailey, a gardener, was living, and presumably working, in Lincolnshire. His father was William Bailey, who was also a gardener. Joseph had been born at Bodenham in Herefordshire.

A witness to the wedding was Edward Hindley (1867-1948) the oldest brother of Emily.

After the wedding it is likely that Joseph and Emily went to live in Lincolnshire. By the time of the **1891 Census** they were living at Girsby Grange, Burgh on Bain, Lincolnshire. Joseph was a gardener and Emily had two young children; aged two, and eleven months, and they had been born at Girsby.

At the time of the **1901 Census** the family was probably still in the same place as for the 1891 Census as all their five children are listed as being born at Girsby. Their address for this Census was given as "Near Manor, Burgh on Bain, Brough on Bain, Lincolnshire. Joseph was 37 years old and Emily was 35.

The **1911 Census** told us that the oldest four children had left home, leaving just Rowland Powell Bailey, aged 12, who was still at school. Joseph was 47 and still a gardener, Emily was 45, and they had been married for 23 years.

For the next 40 years it is likely that Emily and Joseph continued to live at Burgh on Bain, Lincolnshire.

Then on 19<sup>th</sup> May 1951 Joseph died. PROBATE records tell us:-

**Bailey Joseph Henry of Manor View, Burgh-on-Bain, Lincolnshire died 19<sup>th</sup> May 1951. Probate Lincoln to Emily Bailey, widow.**

Emily then seems to have moved back to Cheshire. Her daughter, Lily Bailey, was employed as a housekeeper to Edward Hindley (1867-1948) since the death of Edward's wife in 1923. Edward was a brother of Emily and after his death it seems that Lily Bailey stayed on in the same house. Emily is likely to have moved to Stockport to be with her daughter as she died there on 20<sup>th</sup> January 1955.

Emily's PROBATE record is:-
