1843 James was born on 17th October 1843 at Catchwell Cottage, Runcorn Road, Barnton, Northwich, Cheshire. His Civil Registration birth was recorded at Northwich in the fourth quarter of 1843. James was the oldest of 11 children, four of whom died before they were five years old. BGBGBBGBBGB

1851 His early life was spent at Catchwell Cottage, Barnton. In the **1851 Census** James was aged 7, living with his parents.

1861 By the time of the **1861 Census** James was a Waterman, still living with his parents.

1864 Marriage. At 20 years of age James married a Northwich girl, Sarah Dickens also aged 20, at Great Budworth Parish Church on 14th April 1864. James is still a Waterman. **Sarah is, in fact, only 17 years of age.**

Married in the *Parish Church* according to the Rites and Ceremonies of the Established Church, by *James* or after *James* by me, *Thomas A Swift*

This Marriage was solemnized between us, *James Hindley* in the Presence of us, *Henry Haslewell* *Sarah Dickens* *J. May Dickens*

Sarah Dickens' birth was registered at Northwich in the first quarter of 1847. She was baptised at Great Budworth Church on 7th March 1847. Her parents were listed as George and Susanna Dickens.

1864 The birth of their first child (Sarah Jane) was registered at Northwich, Cheshire, in the last quarter of 1864.

1867 Their second, and last child, (Mary Hannah) had her birth registered at Northwich in 1866(Q4). She was baptised at Barnton on 20th January 1867.

Her date of birth is written in the left hand margin, December 10th 1866.

James and Sarah moved house more than most people at this time, probably as a result of James having several different jobs.

1871 In the **1871 Census** they are living in the Godly, Ashton Under Lyne, area of Lancashire. James is a labourer at a paint works.

1881 At the time of the **1881 Census** they are living at Penistone in the West Riding of Yorkshire. James is a shunter at a steel works.

1891 The **1891 Census** shows that they are back in Cheshire, at Middlewich. James is a general labourer.

1890s In the 1890s James and Sarah returned to Barnton and took over a shop in the Tunnel Top area. The shop sold general provisions such as "A penny worth of treacle".

1897 In 1897 their eldest daughter became ill, and they moved to 26 George Street, Barnton. Sarah Jane died in 1898 at the age of 34.

James appears in the Register of Electors for Barnton from **1896-1898** at 22 Canal Side. (Probably his shop address). In **1899** he has a property at 17 Runcorn Road.

JAMES HINDLEY (1843-1913)

1901 At the time of the **1901 Census** James and Sarah are in Barnton, at 26 George Street. James is a labourer at an Alkali Works, *almost certainly Brunner Mond*.

1911 By the time of the **1911 Census** James had retired.

1913 James and Sarah were still living at 26 George Street, Barnton when James died on **7th January 1913**, aged 69.

1917 Sarah Hindley's death, at the age of 70, was registered at Northwich in 1917(Q1). She actually died on 10th February 1917 and was short of 70 years old by a month.

James was a very strict man. He used to stand his children in a corner and say "Anchor". *In his early working days James was a waterman so Anchor was perhaps not inappropriate.*

1901 January 29th - Item in a Sheffield Newspaper.

Mid-Cheshire was yesterday visited by a series of storms. Snow, rain and hail fell at intervals, accompanied by thunder and lightning. At Winnington, Northwich, Chemical Works, a labourer named James Hindley, Barnton, was struck by lightning in a strange manner. He was working on a new caustic plant, and the electrical fluid was conducted by a steel rope which he had just picked up. He fell unconscious, but two medical men succeeded in restoring animation.
