Frederick Wallgate Hindley is likely to have been born in December 1880 at Weaverham. The original sheets of the 1881 Census, taken on 3<sup>rd</sup> April, told us he was 3 months old. The birth of Frederick Wallgate Hindley was registered at Northwich, Cheshire, in the fourth quarter of 1880.

Frederick was christened on 8th May 1881 at Weaverham Parish Church; listed on P.216 of the Church Register for Baptisms. He was the eleventh child of David and Beatrice Hindley. **BGGBGGBBBG**

At the time of the **1881** Census Frederick was three months old and living with his parents in Beech Lane, Weaverham. His father, David, was 40 and his mother, Beatrice, was 38 years old. Also in the house were 3 brothers and 4 sisters plus Beatrice's mother, Mary Dennison.

In the **1891** Census Frederick was 10 years old, a scholar, and he was living at Clay Cross House, Anderton with his parents, three brothers and four sisters.

Frederick's father died in **1894** but his mother was allowed to stay at Clay Cross House with her children.

Frederick was still at Claycroft House for the **1901** Census. His mother, 58 years old, had four sons and two daughters living with her. Frederick was 20 years old and an apprentice Engine Fitter.

At the time of the **1911** Census Frederick was lodging at 46 Gladstone Street, Widnes. He was 30 years of age, single, and employed as an Engine Fitter.

Frederick must have been planning to join his brother, Oswald, in Canada before the 1911 Census. On 27<sup>th</sup> April 1911 he boarded a ship at Liverpool and sailed for Montreal. Once in Canada it is likely that he travelled by train to Alberta to meet up with Oswald.

The details of Frederick's boat journey are shown below. He was called Fred on the passenger sheet. The original entries were very difficult to read but his passenger number was 67739. He was Church of England, heading for Calgary, Alberta, with 50 Canadian Dollars.

Oswald and Frederick appear in the **1911** Canadian Census. They were in Calgary, Alberta. Oswald was 34 and Frederick was 30 years old. They were in Enumeration District 23, Page 19, Entry 194.

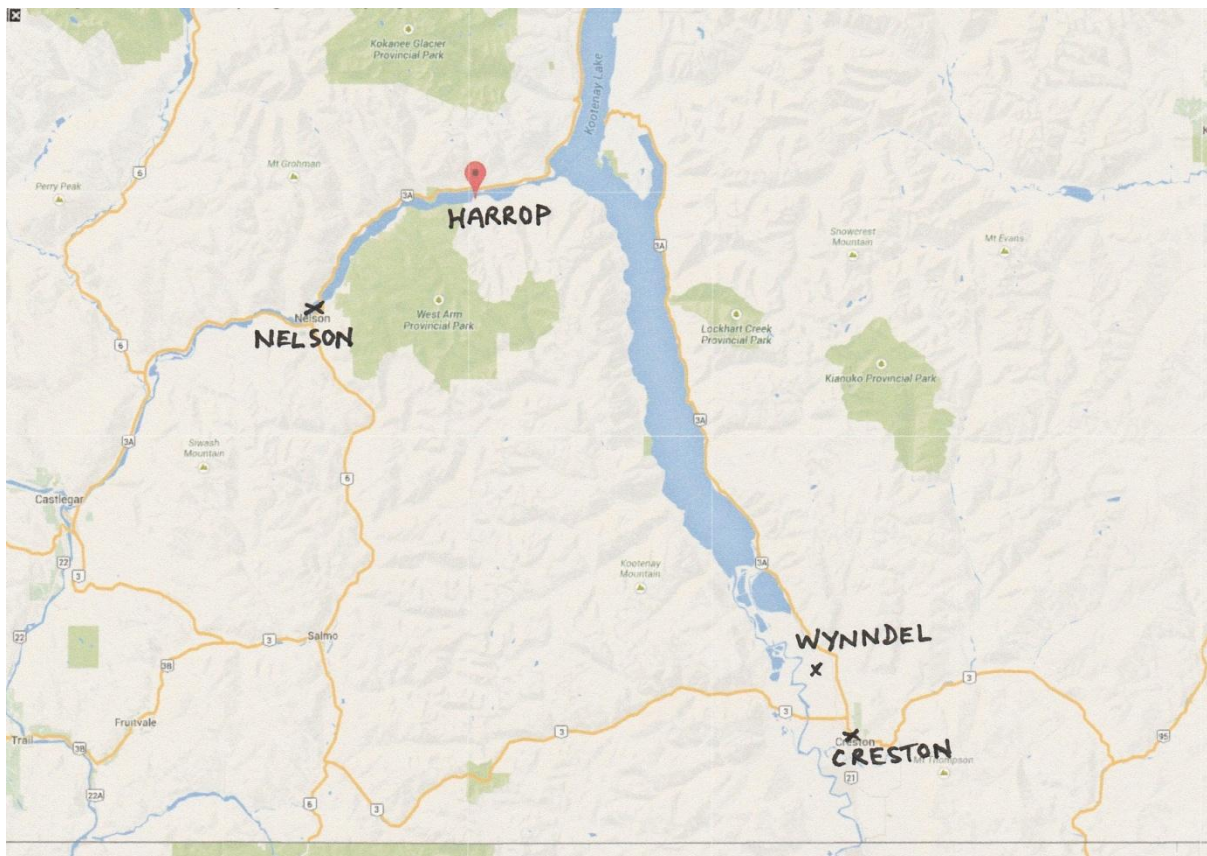
The youngest brother, Charles, arrived in Canada on 27<sup>th</sup> April **1913**. He was also heading for Calgary, Alberta.

If Frederick followed Oswald and Charles he would have moved to Wynndel, near Creston, British Columbia by May **1917**.

However, Frederick might have moved to Nelson as his brother, John, emigrated to Canada in **1921**. John arrived in Canada by boat on 29<sup>th</sup> March 1921. On the passenger Immigration Form John had stated that he was going to join his brothers and sister. He was going to F.W.Hindley at Clay Cross, Nelson, Harrop, B.C. (Clay Cross was also the name of their family home in England.)

In **1935** Frederick was registered as a voter (with sister Rose and brother John) in the Kootenay West division of British Columbia, Rural polling Division No. 44, Harrop and Long Beach.

Frederick, of Harrop, was a **Rancher**.

A friend of mine knows something of the area around Creston and Nelson.

“ I’ve not been there, but they`re both in the south east of BC - and certainly "settler" towns - lots of orchards and timber mills and that sort of thing - and beautiful. I looked up Wynndel and Harrop on the map and they seem to be in the same area as Nelson and Creston, but small communities. Lots of forests and mountains - very beautiful. Essondale is part of Coquitlan which is now part of the big sprawl of Vancouver. It's on the river, so again, lots of work to be had there, as the Fraser River was key to much of the work then.”

Frederick died in 1951 at Essondale when he was 69 years old.
