Edward was born at Catchwell Cottage, Runcorn Road, Barnton, Northwich, Cheshire, on 13th October 1887. **BBBBGB**

He was brought up in a Methodist family.

In the **1891** Census Edward was 3 years old. He was living with his parents, four brothers and a sister on Runcorn Road, Barnton, Cheshire (*at Catchwell Cottage*).

The **1901** Census told us that Edward was still at school, aged 13. He was living at 88 Runcorn Road, Barnton with his parents, four brothers and his sister.

After finishing school Edward worked for his father at Acton Bridge.

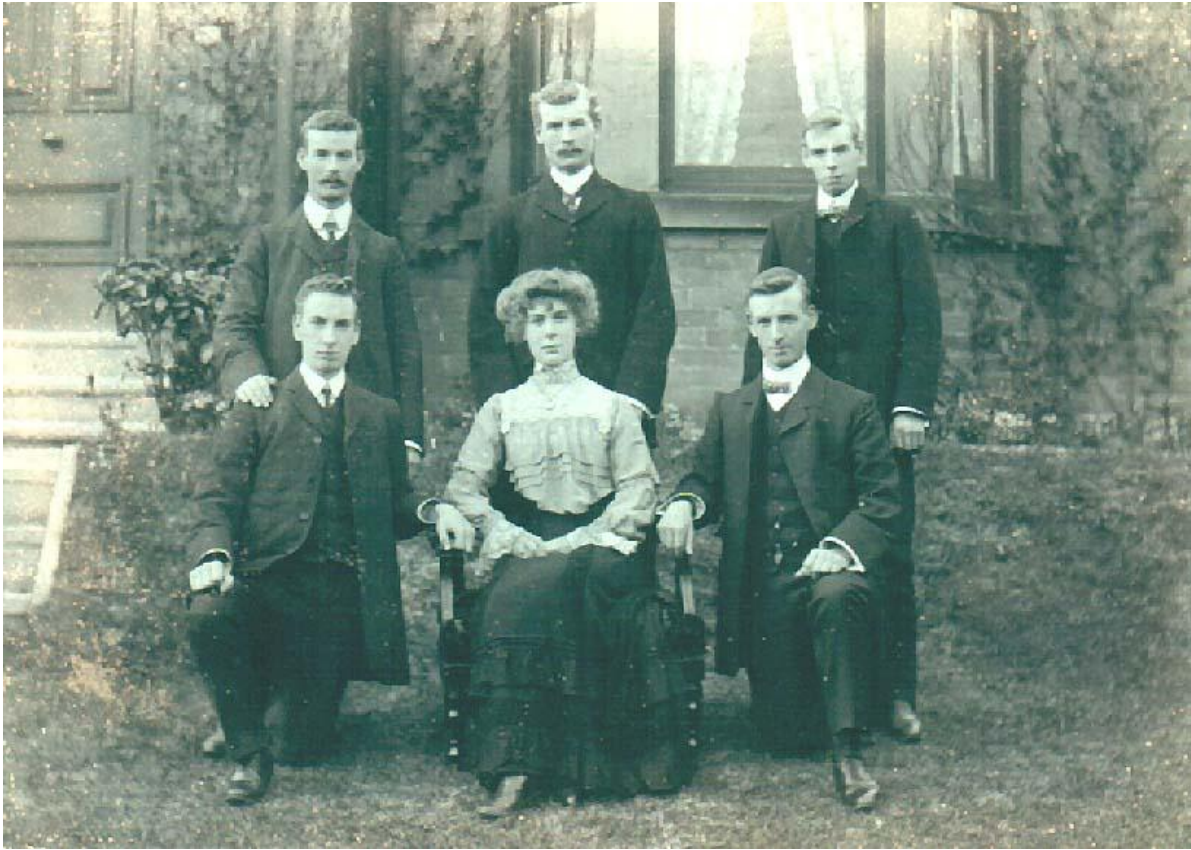
At the time of the **1911** Census he was 23 and single, a Chemist, living at 88 (The Poplars), Runcorn Road, Barnton. His parents and sister were also in the household.

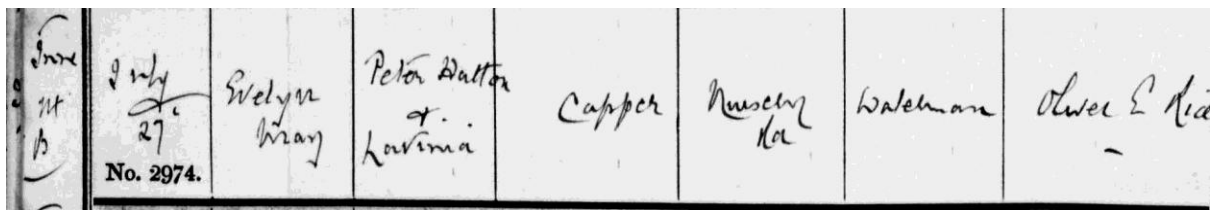

Edward became a food chemist at Acton Bridge (where the Rheingold restaurant was situated 1997 and where the offices of his father's firm were originally sited *c1905*. In 2015 the restaurant was called The Riverside.). Edward junior removed oil from soya and sold the patent to Bibby's Oil and Cattle Cake Company in Liverpool. He also had a shed near the Willows Garage on Runcorn Road, Barnton where he prepared "Health Foods".

In 1912 Edward might have sailed to America to visit his brother, Thomas. Ed Hindley, single, is listed as travelling by boat from Liverpool to New York.

Edward was 42 years old when he married. He married a Barnton girl, May Capper, in the third quarter of **1931**. Evelyn May Capper was baptised at Barnton Church on 27<sup>th</sup> July 1902. She was the daughter of Peter Hatton Capper (a waterman) and Lavinia. They were living in Nursery Road, Barnton. May's date of birth, 14<sup>th</sup> June, is written vertically in the Church register.

Edward lived in a house built for him as a wedding present from his parents on land belonging to "The Poplars", his father's home. His house, 84 Runcorn Road, Barnton, is next door to "The Poplars".

Around 1920 his father's business had been taken over to form a larger firm and by 1929 the Acton Bridge site had closed.

At some unknown date Edward opened a business at Sutton Weaver, near Runcorn, trading under the name of "Dainty Products". He used his analytical chemical skills to make jellies, blancmange powder and cleaning fluids.

Edward had to close his business when war broke out in 1939 as he was unable to obtain raw materials.

During The Second World War he worked for ICI, testing gases.

In **1945** Edward left the district and with his wife, May, they opened a boarding house at Lytham St. Annes (south of Blackpool), Lancashire.

A young relative used to stay for holidays at the boarding house Edward and Auntie May had in St. Anne's. She remembers playing the piano there and impressing other guests as she played by ear, which they thought was wonderful !

Edward was an executor of his father's Will. He became deeply troubled, partly through duties involved in carrying out the terms of the Will, and he ended his life in the water at Longton Marsh (south-west of Preston) on 21<sup>st</sup> January **1949**.

**Probate:**

HINDLEY Edward of 171 St. Andrew's-road South St. Annes-on-Sea Lancashire died 6<sup>th</sup> April 1949 at Longton Marsh Longton Lancashire. Probate Chester 12<sup>th</sup> August to May Hindley widow.

May Hindley re-married in the second quarter of 1954. She married Frank Wright. The marriage was registered in the Fylde district of Lancashire. Frank died soon afterwards on 24<sup>th</sup> May 1955, aged 66 years at no.171 St. Andrews Road South. May died on 28<sup>th</sup> April 1959 at the age of 56 years.

**Probate:**

WRIGHT May of 7 Winston Avenue St Annes-on-Sea Lytham St Annes Lancashire widow died 28<sup>th</sup> April 1959. Probate Lancaster 11<sup>th</sup> September to Robert Edward Hindley audit clerk Frank Vincent Wright maintenance manager and John Bransby Windle solicitor.
