Harry was born on 13th January 1880 at a house close to Leigh's Brow, on Runcorn Road, Barnton, Northwich, Cheshire. **GGBBGGBG**

He moved with his family to 1 Nursery Road, Barnton when his father had the house built about 1886.

In the **1891 Census** Harry was aged 11, a scholar, born at Barnton, and he was living with his parents in Nursery Road, Barnton.

When his mother died in August 1891 Harry and the rest of the family were looked after by Annie for five years until Thomas married his second wife on 3rd October 1896. Annie, the eldest child, was just 16 years old in August 1891.

At the time of the **1901 Census** Harry was 21 years old, single, and employed as a bricklayer. He was living with his father Thomas, Thomas' second wife Mary, his brother George and sister Lucy. They were all living at 1 Nursery Road, Barnton.

After leaving school Harry became an apprentice bricklayer at Appleton's (the builders) in Winnington. After his marriage he built his own home at 145 Lydyett Lane, Barnton (opposite Hayes Drive).

On 16th September **1905** Harry married Margaret Ellen Boden, of Hartford, at Barnton Parish Church. She was also known as Alice Boden and Cissie Boden. Alice Boden was the daughter of Walter and Elizabeth Boden. The birth of Margaret Ellen Boden was registered at Northwich in the fourth quarter of 1876.

This Marriage was solemnized between us, *Harry Hindley* and *Margaret Ellen Boden* in the Presence of us, *George Hindley* and *Esther Boden* *H. Thomas* Vicar

Harry's brother, George, was a witness to the wedding.

The **1911 Census** told us that Harry and Margaret Ellen were living at Old Road, Anderton. Harry was 31 years old and Cissie was 34. They had been married for 5 years.

Harry served in the First World War which lasted from 1914-1918. I have not been able to find his service number as there were quite a few Harry Hindleys in WW1 online records, and the information was very sparse with no addresses given.

Harry was badly injured during the War after having an eye shot out. He never really recovered and was frequently troubled with terrible headaches. He eventually committed suicide, as a result of his war wounds, on 8th January 1926. Harry was found by his brother, George, in the brook of the local Gunnersclough Wood. Harry was 45 years old.

After Harry died Alice married John Cross, a widower who already had two daughters. Alice did not have any children of her own.

Margaret Ellen Cross of 145 Lydyett Lane, Barnton died on 18th April 1964 at Holmcroft, Arclid, Sandbach, Cheshire.
