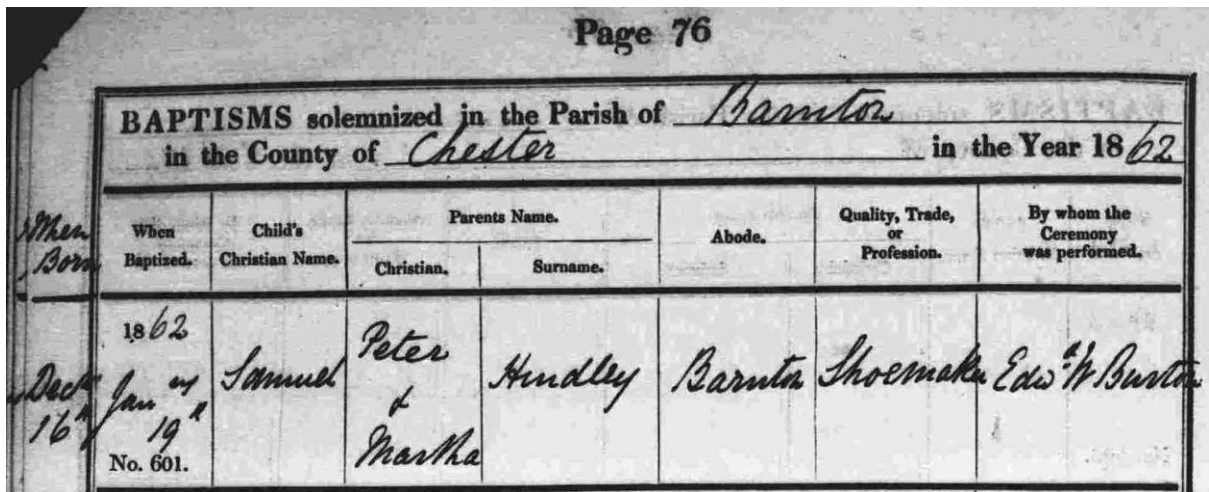

Samuel was born on 16<sup>th</sup> December 1861 at Catchwell Cottage, Runcorn Road, Barnton, Northwich, Cheshire. BGGBBBGGBBG He was the youngest of 11 children, 4 of whom died before they were 5 years old.

Samuel was baptised at Barnton Church on January 19th 1862. His date of birth is recorded in the left hand column, December 16<sup>th</sup> 1861.



In the **1871 Census** Samuel was aged 9, scholar, born at Barnton, and living with his parents at Runcorn Road, Barnton, (Catchwell Cottage).

The **1881 Census** showed Samuel to be aged 19, a ships carpenter, and still living with his parents at Runcorn Road, Barnton.

By **1883** Samuel is likely to have been working in the Manchester area as he met a Manchester girl, Sarah Alice Rudd.

*Sarah Alice's birth was recorded at Manchester in the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter of 1856. In the 1861 Census she would have been aged 4 but she was not living with her parents Joseph and Margaret, probably as she was being cared for by a relative whilst her mother had a baby, John Thomas. Sarah Alice Rudd is back home at 5 Atherton Street, Manchester, at the time of the 1871 Census. Her mother is head of household (46) and a Charwoman. "Sarah A" is 14 years of age, born at Manchester, and working as a Cotton Weaver.*

**Samuel Hindley married Sarah Alice Rudd at Manchester in the third quarter of 1883.** It was a Civil Registration Marriage – not a church wedding. Volume 8D Page 301.

In **1884** Samuel joined the Police Force, as a Reservist. The Manchester Police Index for 1812-1941 shows that Samuel joined the Police Force on 18<sup>th</sup> February 1884, at the age of 22. He was born at Barnton, Cheshire, was married, and his religion was given as Church of England. He was in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Cheshire RV. Presumably he was in reserve for when extra police were needed.

The **1891 Census** showed that Samuel and Sarah Alice were living at 31 Derby Street, Salford with Margaret Rudd (mother of Sarah Alice) and Beatrice Rudd, aged 4. Samuel was 28, a Ship Carpenter, and Sarah Alice was 34.

At the time of the **1901 Census** Samuel and Sarah Alice were living at 17 Humber Street, Pendleton. Samuel was aged 38, a shipwright, and Sarah Alice was 44. Margaret Rudd, aged 68 and an Office Cleaner was still with them.

Samuel and Sarah Alice had moved back to Northwich by the time of the **1911 Census**. They were at 14 Winnington Lane. Samuel, 48, was a Ship Carpenter (*probably with Brunner Mond.*) Samuel and Sarah Alice had been married for 27 years.

At some point Samuel is believed to have lived at 287 Runcorn Road, Barnton (the end one of the terraced houses) and also at a house in the middle of that terraced block. Sam's brother, Edward, owned that block of houses.

Sam used to take Alfred Hindley pike fishing at Anderton, in the Witton Brook area.

**According to Alice (Hindley) Hitchinson Sam married "Aunt Sarah Alice \_\_\_\_\_" (at a later date this proved to be correct). Aunt Sarah Alice was very prim and proper, but very nice. Uncle Sam was a huge fellow, and also very nice.**

Around **1920** Sam and Sarah Alice were living at 95 Runcorn Road, Barnton. Samuel died on 28th June 1922. The National Register of Deaths lists a Samuel Hindley who died aged 60 at Chorlton in the second quarter of 1922. (8c 946).

**PROBATE** (for Samuel)

Hindley Samuel of 95 Runcorn Road, Barnton, near Northwich, Cheshire, retired shipwright died 28<sup>th</sup> June 1922 at the Royal Infirmary, Manchester. Probate Chester 8<sup>th</sup> September to Sarah Alice Hindley, widow.

Four years later Sarah Alice's death was registered at Northwich. In the England/Wales Death Indexes Sarah J. Hindley's death was registered in Northwich in 1926(Q2), aged 68. (Ref. 8a 322).

**PROBATE** (for Sarah Alice)

From Probate records, "Hindley Sarah Alice of the Red House, Northwich, Cheshire, widow, died 3<sup>rd</sup> June 1926. Probate Chester 16<sup>th</sup> July to Edward Hindley Director of a limited company.
