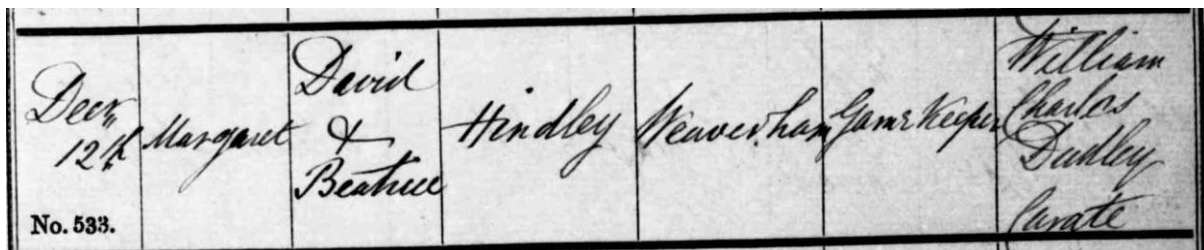

Margaret was the first daughter of David and Beatrice Hindley.

She was baptised at Weaverham Parish Church on 12th Dec. 1863. Her entry is recorded on page 67 of the Church register for births.



In the **1871 Census** Margaret Hindley was aged 7 years, born at Weaverham, and living with her parents in Beech Lane, Weaverham.

The **1881 Census** tells us that Margaret was still living in Beech Lane, Weaverham with her parents. She was 17 years of age and a Domestic Servant at home.

By the time of the **1891 Census** Margaret had moved, with her parents, to Clay Croft House, Anderton. She was aged 27, single, and she was employed as a bookshop assistant.

In the **1901 Census** Margaret was at Clay Croft House, Anderton, with her mother, one sister and four brothers. (Her father died in 1894). She was single, and working as a Jewelry Shop Assistant.

Margaret had left home before the **1911 Census**. She had opened her own shop at Turton, near Bolton, selling "Fancy Goods". She employed her sister, Rose, as a shop assistant. Margaret was 47 at the time of the Census and Rose was 40. They were both

lodging at 112 Bradshaw Brow, Turton, near Bolton. It is likely that Margaret started her business around 1908/9 as Rose had resigned from her teaching job in June 1908.

It is 46 more years before anything else is known about Margaret .

In 1947, at the age of 83, Margaret made arrangements to go and live with her brothers and sister in Canada. She decided to fly, and in 1947 transatlantic flight was in its infancy so it must have been quite a lengthy and interesting journey. Her details are recorded by the Canadian Immigration Service on 12th October 1947 (Volume 1, page 124). See MARG/5

From the above data it would seem that Margaret did not have any close relatives left in England, so she has named a friend.

Margaret had been in Canada for 5 years when she died, aged 89 on 27th June 1953.

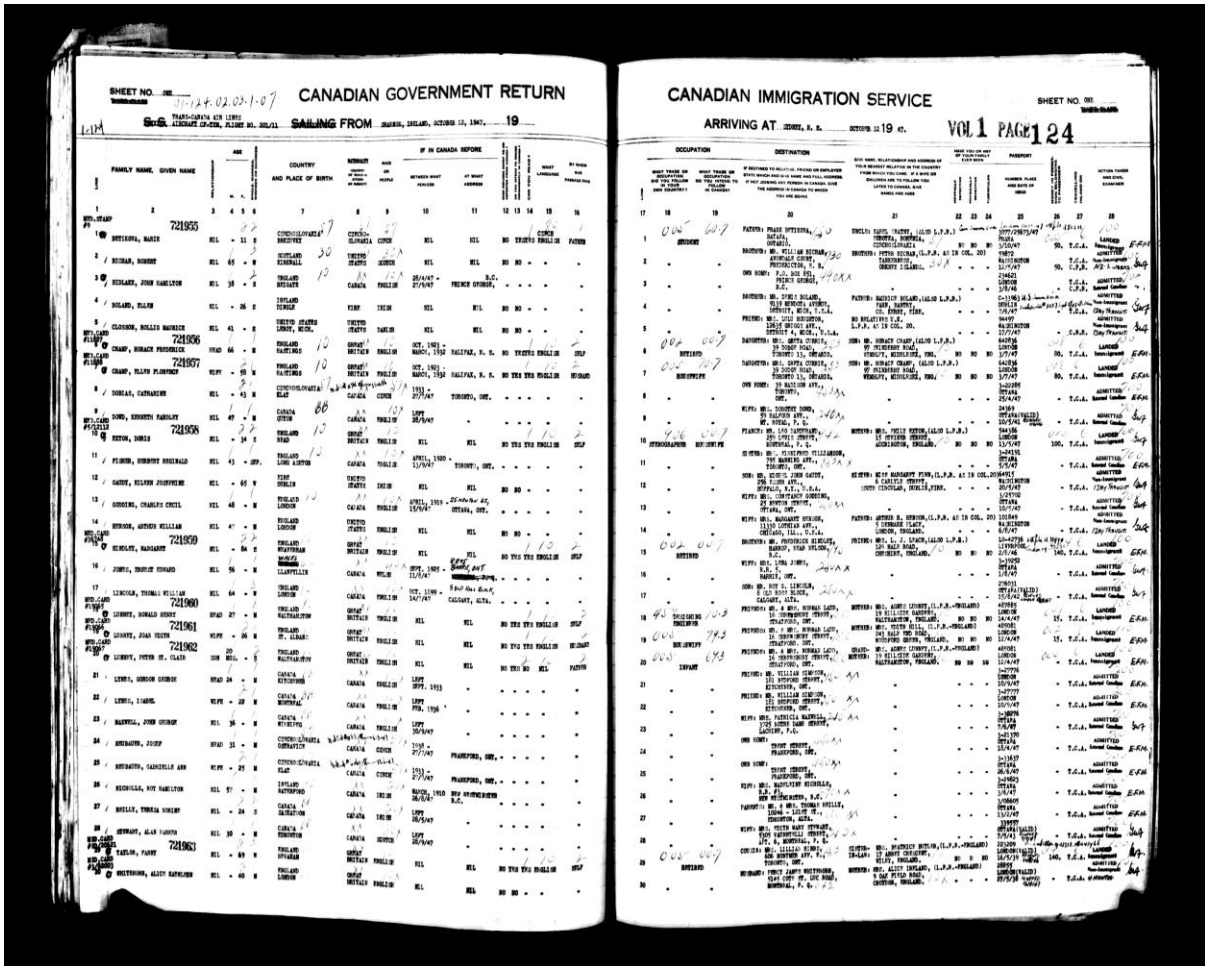

1954 Hindley Margaret of Wynndel, British Columbia, Canada, spinster, died 27th June 1953 at Creston, British Columbia. Probate Nelson to Charles Hindley, farmer. Effects £1074-17s-11d in England. Sealed London, 26th July 1954.

So Margaret had left some items of value in England. Quite possibly she owned a house in England.



1947 The above document is a Canadian Government return for 12th October 1947. It is the original passenger data for Trans Canadian Airlines, flight no. 201/11 from Shannon, Ireland, to Sydney, Nova Scotia. Margaret's details are on line 15, out of 30, on this sheet.

Margaret's passport had been issued at Liverpool on 2nd August 1946 (no. LO-42736).
