1842 A manuscript written in 1878 by Joseph Hindley (father) lists the birth of Hannah as 26th of October 1842 at Antrobus, Cheshire. (see *Joseph Hindley (1806-1892)*. GBBBBGBGGBGGGB Hannah was born at 3pm, the oldest of twin girls according to the information I obtained from a member of staff at Warrington Registry Office.

(In 1993 I trawled through the registers at Warrington which were listed in quarterly groups with no exact figures for the births, deaths and marriages. I was allowed to ask 10 questions that could be answered with a yes or no. One of my questions revealed that Hannah was the eldest twin).

I went to the Registry Office at Crewe in order to obtain the birth certificate of Hannah.

1851 In the 1851 Census Hannah was 9 years of age, living at Reed House Cottage, Antrobus, with her parents.

1861 By 1961 she was working as a House Servant on the farm of Samuel Joynson at Seven Oaks, near Antrobus.

1865 Hannah married William Mills of Barnton, with the Civil Registration being recorded at Warrington, Lancashire, in the first quarter of 1865. (Volume 8c Page 157).

William Mills' birth was registered in the fourth quarter of 1837 at Northwich, Cheshire. (Volume 19 Page 139).

Banns were read on December 4th, 11th and 18th. They married at Warrington on 8th January 1865. William was 27 and Hannah was 22 years old. At the time of marriage William was living in Sankey Street and Hannah was in Bridge Street, Warrington.
